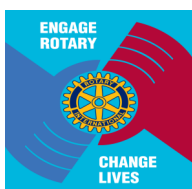

Come together right now over me

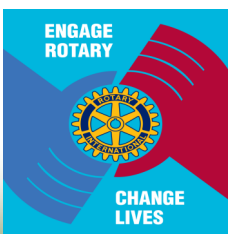

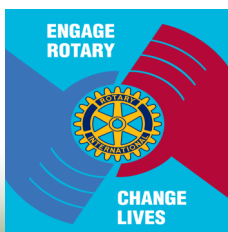

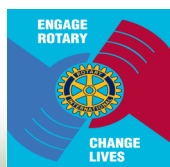
